Stereo Stories is a concert celebration of music and memoir, featuring established and emerging writers and The Stereo Stories Band. It is a show about the songs that shape our lives.

Stereo Stories is a tightly-scripted concert in which writers narrate short memoirs based on a song (up to 600 words), interspersed by The Stereo Stories Band playing parts of the song.

Its writers have included Brian Nankervis, Markus Zusak, Andy Griffiths, Melanie Cheng, Jenny Valentish, Torre deRoche, Emily Maguire, Danny Katz, Tony Birch, Toni Jordan, Chris Hammer, Jock Serong, Clare Wright, Krissy Kneen and Arnold Zable, plus regular members of the Stereo Stories ensemble.

The show has been a hit at festivals since its debut in 2014 at the Williamstown Literary Festival, where its audience has grown from 60 in 2014 to nearly 400 in 2022.
